Children are invited to attend a Sunday school class when they turn 2 years old. A loving nursery is provided younger children. The two year old class participates with Toddlers & Two's. Our three and four year old combined class uses the Rock Solid curriculum. Children experience Bible stories in a read-a-long format. Children then have a hands on activity that relates back to the story.

Our kindergarteners through fifth graders participate in the Workshop Rotation Model. The rotation model teaches major Bible stories and concepts through kid-friendly multimedia workshops: an Art, Storytelling, Drama, Games, Video, and a Mixed Bag of other activities. Teachers teach the same Bible story in all of the workshops for five weeks rotating the children to a different workshop each week. The repetition of the story helps children to develop a lasting memory and understanding of the content and gives the children the opportunity to learn in a creative atmosphere.

Youth & Adult Sunday School Classes

Youth Sunday School

Grades 6-7 Middle school Sunday school has a pre-confirmation focus using the PC(USA) resource, “I Know My Bible.” One year is spent in the Old Testament and one year in the New Testament. This class is taught by Eileen Douglas and Tom Foster.

Grade 8 and above may attend our year-long Confirmation Class. Participants explore what they personally believe and then are introduced to the basic beliefs and organizational structure of the PC(USA). Please note that there is no upper age requirement to attend. This class is taught by Art & Sarah Glover, David White.

Grades 9-12 High school Sunday school utilizes various resources to reflect on and discuss contemporary issues facing young adults today. Examples of resources include videos and other media. John McCorkle & Tom Boyles lead this class.

Presbyterianism Class

If you are thinking of becoming a member of First Presbyterian Church, or you would simply like to refresh your knowledge of the denominational “distinctives,” the ministers and other staff members lead the discussion of basic Presbyterian beliefs as well as what’s happening at FPC. This class meets once a quarter for 6 weeks in a classroom upstairs in the main building.

Martha Brown Bible Study

This class has begun a series of lessons looking at Old Testament figures. Subjects include Ruth, Gideon, Samson, Deborah, Solomon, Isaiah and Jeremiah. Teachers are Dave Perry, Bill Poe and Doug Clark. The class meets in the Fellowship Hall and visitors are welcome. Great coffee too!

Kerygma Bible Study

The Kerygma Adult Sunday School class is studying “If You Want to Walk on Water, You’ve Got to Get Out of the Boat” and meets on the 1st floor of the main building in the Business Administrator’s Office.

Cloud of Witnesses

The Cloud of Witnesses class is a discussion group led by Jequita Bailey, Kay Kelly and Mary Morgan. This class meets in Ken’s office. Participants are studying servant leadership and community building. During special liturgical seasons this class often breaks from the usual format to look at why and how we celebrate as Christians.

This is a great class for folks who find themselves busy with other commitments that sometimes means missing Sunday school. Each Sunday is self-contained and does not depend on the previous week’s lesson. Newcomers welcome!

Presbyterian Home Class

This class meets at the Presbyterian Home each Sunday. Sam Kasias teaches this class using “The Present Word,” the same adult curriculum used in the Christian Life Class.

Feeding the Soul

This class selects topics for study according to interests and needs of the group. The format for presentations include video and guest speakers as well as lively discussion. This class also enjoys fellowship gatherings outside the weekly Sunday school hour. Frosty Culp and Ked Powell lead this class which meets in the Chapel on the first floor of the main building.

Richard Meisky Class

The Richard Meisky Sunday School Class meets in the Parlor and is taught by Doyle Early, with assistance from John Lucas. This class is currently viewing and discussing Rob Bell’s video series.

The Christian Life

The Christian Life Class meets in the Session Room on the main floor of the church. Through “The Present Word,” published by the PC(USA), teachers and learners come together to reflect on the biblical text and to act on what they discover. David Laws leads this class with assistance from Rev. Terry Hedgpeth.
